- Initial sessions start at 30 minutes
- You may extend your session 3 times if no other patron is waiting on a terminal for a total of 120 minutes
- Black and white prints are available at .10 per page and must be paid for upon printing.
- Earbuds may be purchased for \$1
- Staff may authorize longer computer use time for school work and job applications

Library Cards

Library cards are free for residents of Guntersville and Marshall County, Alabama. For those who do not live in Marshall County, a library card can be purchased for a one-time \$5 fee. There is a \$2 replacement fee for lost cards.

There is no minimum age to have a library card, but library members under the age of 18 should have a responsible adult linked to their account.

Borrowing & Returning Library Items

Loan Limits

First checkout is limited to 3 items

Adults– 20 books, *5 DVDs, 5 Audio

Children– 10 books, *5 DVDs, 5 Audio

*Limit of one season of any series

Loan Period

All materials are checked out for 2 weeks

Late Fees

The overdue fine for all materials is 10 cents per day per item, with a maximum fine of \$10 per item.

Renewals

You may renew items twice as long as they are not on reserve for another patron. Renewals can be done from home by logging into your account on our website and using the 4 digit pin number you created when your card was made. You may also call the library and ask for your items to be renewed.

Reserves

Only items that are currently checked out may be placed on hold. We will notify you as soon as your requested item is ready for pick up and will hold it for 3 days at the front desk.
